

# Camp Rules and Packing List

## Camp Regulations

1. No one is allowed to leave the boundaries of the camp.
2. Participants must obey the order of the group leader and the camp director.
3. Participants must follow the camp's cleanliness regulations, and keep the campgrounds clean at all times.
4. The camp uniform is limited to full scouting uniform, neckerchief, scouting t-shirts and all plain t-shirts. Scouts will be asked to remove clothing that is vulgar or offensive in nature. All shirts must cover the shoulders; **no tank tops or spaghetti straps** are allowed.
5. All shirts must be Homenetmen Chapter Shirts, Armenian Organizational Shirts, or plain shirts. All shirts that are not in the above category shall not be permitted at camp. Armenian writing only on the shirts, unless they are manufactured and distributed by one of the above entities.

**Sweatshirts are the only item of clothing that are permitted to contain English/non-Homenetmen writing on them (Sweatshirts that are vulgar or offensive in nature are not allowed).**

6. **Make up, nail polish** or jewelry is prohibited at camp.
7. All items that are brought to camp that are not on the "Items to Bring List" shall be confiscated.
8. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages, sodas, or electronic equipment of any kind are permitted.
9. No open toed shoes or slippers will be permitted outside the pool and shower area.

**Failure to comply with these regulations and the rules set forth by the leaders will result in harsh disciplinary actions or expulsion from the campsite administered by the troop leaders, supervised by the camp director, and in no case will be refunded the price of camp fees.**

## What to Bring to Camp!

**Limit: One Medium Sized Luggage per Child and 1 Sleeping bag.  
Mark all Clothing and Sleeping Bag with Child's Name.**

### Personal Belongings:

1. **Full Uniform including Neckerchief, Hat and Black Shoes**
2. Backpack
3. Sleeping Bag/Pillow (We strongly encourage a blanket and a pillow)
4. Change of Clothes (long pants, jackets, sweatshirts, socks, shorts and shirts for intended number of days of stay plus one additional day)
5. Shoes

6. Hat
7. Toiletry Kit (Toothbrush, Toothpaste, hand soap, body soap, shampoo Q-tips, chap stick etc.)
8. 1 extra trash bag to place sleeping bag or used clothes in upon return
9. Flashlight and spare batteries
10. **SUNSCREEN**
11. Notebook, Pen and Pencil
12. Reusable water bottle
13. A trash bag sized plastic bag to store used clothing.

## **What Not to Bring**

1. Weapons, sheath knives, guns, ammo, bows and arrows, sling shots  
(Folding pocket knives are allowed for Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts that have Pen Gark)
2. Alcohol, drugs, tobacco (Possession, consumption, and/or participation in such activities are grounds for automatic expulsion from the camp and subject to further disciplinary action)
3. Gum, snacks, candy, chocolate, sunflower seeds, food of any sort
4. Glass or breakable items of any kind
5. Matches, Candles, Incense, Liquid or Gas Fuels, or Fireworks
6. Electronic Devices including Cell Phones, Music Devices, and Personal Entertainment Devices will be confiscated immediately. **(Safekeeping of these items upon confiscation is not guaranteed)**

## **Medications:**

**Any and all medication must be enclosed in an envelope with your child's name with a description and instructions of when to take the medication. This envelope must be turned in to K. Bianca prior to departure from Crescenta Valley Park.**
